Toronto, ON – Project Eve, a consortium of Canadian companies, announced today that it has signed a definitive agreement with **MDA** to advance essential electric mobility technologies and solutions.

Under the terms of the agreement, Project Eve and MDA will combine their collective capabilities to advance key enabling technologies; to coordinate marketing and business development efforts; and to design, deliver and enhance advanced electric mobility technologies and solutions.

“Electric mobility is an area where we believe our expertise, assets and capabilities can add value. Our previous work with similar technologies in extreme operating conditions can be part of the progress needed to realize some of the potential inherent in electric mobility, said **Roy Jakola, Director, Terrestrial Applications** for MDA.
